








RIDING THE FUTURE WITH YAVALINE & YAVAPAI REGIONAL TRANSIT (YRT)

Currently, Yavaline is providing transit services in Prescott Valley while YRT provides transit services primarily in Chino Valley. The opportunities to grow the transit footprint in this area are innumerable. CYMPO stands as the region's lone transportation planning organization and is ideally positioned to facilitate transit service delivery collaborations between Yavaline and YRT. 


Annual Total Ridership: 18,046

Walking the Talk: CYMPO's ACT-UP Sets the Stage for Active Transportation

CYMPO recently hosted a public kick-off for its newest major planning process: the active transportation plan known as the “ACT-UP: Active Community Transportation – Unified Plan”. The CYMPO team and its consultant partners from Kittelson led a vibrant conversation with community leaders, partners, and bicycle-pedestrian enthusiasts on November 7th at the Yavapai Co. Public Works Ready Room.



The ACT-UP will be a year-long process that looks at how people are moving about the region. The goal is to strengthen the safety and functionality of our local and regional street networks that cyclists and pedestrians utilize most to get to and from popular destinations, as well as take a look at school campuses and improving facilities for our students who walk or bike to school.
